

CFU offers cost-sharing rebates to help customers pay for energy efficiency measures. **How to qualify:** For HVAC or building shell rebates, start by scheduling a free House Calls energy audit. A CFU Energy Specialist will visit your home to determine eligibility and the optimal size for new heating or cooling equipment. For efficient equipment, recycling or lighting rebates, follow the purchase guidelines below and fill out a rebate application available online or at CFU, 1 Utility Parkway, Cedar Falls.

CFU Residential Energy-Efficiency Rebates - 2010 (Effective 2-1-10)

Efficient Equipment	Rebate Amount
■ Clothes washers	\$100 for ENERGY STAR® model; CFU must provide water heating fuel source
■ Natural gas tankless/gas condensing water heaters	\$300 for ENERGY STAR model with min. EF of 0.82.
■ Dishwashers	\$75 for any unit rated at 307 kwh/yr and 5.0 gallons/cycle or lower.

Appliance Recycling*	Rebate Amount**
■ Standard refrigerators	\$50 (16 cu ft or larger)
■ Freezers	\$50 (16 cu ft or larger)
■ Window air conditioners	\$25
■ Dehumidifiers * Must turn in to the City of Cedar Falls to qualify!	\$25 ** Limit of 2 rebates per appliance type per account/year.

HVAC Systems (must be sized by CFU)	
■ Natural gas boilers	\$400 (minimum 92% AFUE)
■ Natural gas furnaces	\$200 (minimum 95% AFUE)
■ Central air conditioners (14 SEER minimum)	\$200 + \$100 x (SEER-14); \$500 maximum
■ Ground-source heat pumps (open or closed loop) (min. 14.1 EER & 3.3 COP)	\$600/ton new ground loop installs \$300/ton existing ground loop installs
■ Air-source heat pumps (2 stage units only) (min. 15 SEER & 8.5 HSPF)	\$300 + \$100 x (SEER-15); \$600 maximum

Building Shell	Rebate Amount
[CFU must supply your primary heating fuel or a \$200 max limit applies]	
■ Attic/ceiling insulation (up to R-49)	60% of contracted labor, equipment and materials; up to \$1,000
■ Sidewall insulation	60% of contracted labor, equipment and materials; up to \$1,000
■ Foundation insulation	60% of contracted labor, equipment and materials; up to \$1,000
■ Air sealing/caulking/ weather-stripping	60% of contracted labor, equipment and materials; up to \$200

CFLs & Fixtures	Rebate Amount
■ Specialty* CFL bulbs (Any ENERGY STAR qualified CFL in one of these categories: Dimmable or 3-way (any wattage); Higher than 30 watts; Covered CFLs (A-line, bullet, globe, reflector, candle, post) Bare-circuline or bare-twin, triple, or quadruple tube	50% of bulb cost up to \$5 each; 10 per account



■ Fluorescent fixtures or Ceiling fan light kits	\$20 per fixture or kit; limit 6 each per account/yr.

* Standard bare-spiral and mini bare-spiral CFLs do not qualify for the rebate above. CFU provides these bulbs through our House Calls energy audits, and they may be purchased from local retailers at reduced cost through the Change A Light, Change the World promotion, sponsored locally by CFU.

PLEASE NOTE: Improvements made from 1-1-2009 to 1-31-2010 can qualify for 2009 CFU rebate programs. March 31, 2010 is the deadline to apply for those rebates. Clothes washers, dishwashers and other improvements made before February 1, 2010 will NOT receive 2010 program rebates, even if it meets the criteria. Funds for all rebate programs are available on a first-come, first-served basis. CFU may alter or discontinue rebate programs at any time.
