



# 2018 Residential Application: Central Air Conditioners, Existing Properties

**Who should apply:** Existing residential properties or multifamily properties with residential style, forced-air systems – \$400 - \$500 per qualifying unit

**Who should NOT apply:** Commercial facilities or multifamily units without residential-style forced-air systems – Use Commercial Air Conditioner Application Form (multifamily properties with more than 4 units per building can also opt to participate in the CFU Commercial HVAC rebate program, which has different requirements)

**Equipment that is not installed by a SAVE-certified contractor – NOT ELIGIBLE**

**New construction homes or add-on/dual fuel air source heat pumps – NOT ELIGIBLE**

**Air source or ground source heat pumps and ductless mini split systems – Use other CFU rebate forms**

All equipment must meet CFU's sizing requirement and have a SAVE rating of Excellent. Rebate not awarded until SAVE rating has been received.

**NEW COOLING SYSTEM INFORMATION – must be installed by a SAVE-certified contractor, have a SAVE rating of Excellent, and meet CFU's sizing calculation. ## CEDAR FALLS UTILITIES 2018 RESIDENTIAL CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONER REBATE PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **Project Eligibility (including CFU SAVE and Sizing Requirements):** Projects must be completed between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018. Applicant must 1) be a current Cedar Falls Utilities (CFU) customer; 2) own the property where equipment is installed; and 3) CFU must supply the electricity to the central air conditioner for which the cash rebate is being paid. *Equipment must be installed at a residential or multifamily dwelling. Multifamily facilities with more than 4 units per building alternatively have the option of participating in the CFU Commercial HVAC rebate program, which has different requirements.* Projects must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local codes, standards, and regulatory requirements. The most current rules of this program are on the application forms posted at [www.cfu.net](http://www.cfu.net). To evaluate your application, CFU will use the rules listed on the application form that was posted at [www.cfu.net](http://www.cfu.net) on the day CFU receives your application. All equipment must be new; used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible. Existing equipment must be removed and may not be resold. **SAVE Requirements:** At the time of the installation, the equipment installer must be listed as a SAVE-certified contractor at [www.hvacsave.com](http://www.hvacsave.com) and equipment must achieve SAVE-certification (Excellent rating). **Equipment Size Requirements:** CFU Energy Services department must complete a sizing calculation of each central air conditioner *prior* to installation; equipment must not exceed the size listed in CFU's calculations. Maximum equipment size of 65 MBtuh is allowed under this rebate program. Larger systems are subject to other CFU programs.
- **Application Submittal Directions:** After installation and SAVE testing are complete, submit a completed and signed rebate application with invoices and the SAVE contractor report to Cedar Falls Utilities, Attn: Energy Services, P.O. Box 769, Cedar Falls, IA 50613. Reports, invoices, and applications may also be submitted electronically at [energyservices@cfu.net](mailto:energyservices@cfu.net). Itemized receipt(s) or paid invoice(s) showing the contractor/vendor name, date of purchase, installation address, manufacturer and model number of the coil and condenser of each central air conditioner purchased, and each total project cost must be submitted with the rebate application. The SAVE report must be completed using the "CFU SAVE Equipment Rebate" job type at [www.hvacsave.com](http://www.hvacsave.com). *CFU reserves the rights to 1) award rebates in the form of utility bill credits or directly mailed checks; 2) verify invoices and proof of payments with financial institutions; 3) notify you of rebate status via text message; and to 4) request invoices that itemize each air conditioner total project cost separately from costs for furnaces or other projects. For this rebate category, CFU does not consider receipts documenting case transactions a valid proof of payment. See "Rebate Amount" below for definition of total project cost.*
- **Rebate Amount:** CFU's rebate increases by \$100 for the first 1.0 increase in SEER; incremental SEER units are rounded to the SEER below. For example, a 14.7 SEER central air conditioner will receive a \$400 rebate (14.0 SEER incentive level), not a \$500 rebate (rebate level for 15.0 or higher SEER units). *In no event will rebate awarded exceed 50% of the total project cost. Total project cost is the total of equipment and labor costs necessary to complete installation of a single qualifying central air conditioner.*
- **CFU Rebate Processing and Application Deadline:** Submit your application no later than June 30, 2019. Equipment or improvements must be installed and operating on the premises before you apply for a rebate. Unit must be paid in full; items on layaway or payment plans are not eligible until all payments have been made. Allow two to eight weeks for application review and funding of approved rebates. Incomplete applications may be delayed or rejected. CFU reserves the right to award rebates in the form of utility bill credits or directly mailed checks. Limit one rebate payment per piece of qualifying equipment or project expense. **NOTE: Rebates will not be awarded until a SAVE rating of Excellent has been received by CFU. If central air conditioner is installed during cold weather and it's not possible to do a SAVE test, the rebate will not be awarded until a SAVE test is submitted during warmer weather.**
- **Verification & Publicity:** CFU reserves the right to inspect and verify the installation or conduct additional SAVE Equipment tests; ask you to complete a customer survey; and/or meter the specified equipment or process, at no cost to the customer, in order to determine the actual energy saved for up to 12 months after the installation. CFU may publicize your participation in this program unless you request otherwise in writing. Rebate application information may be shared with state agencies or departments.
- **Cedar Falls Utilities:** does not endorse any provider, manufacturer, product, labor or system design by offering this program; 2) is not responsible for any tax liability arising from customer's receipt of a rebate payment; 3) is not responsible for negotiating contractor pricing or expediting contractor work or SAVE score calculation; 4) does not expressly or implicitly warrant the performance of installed equipment or contractor's quality of work (contact your contractor or vendor for warranty information); 5) is not responsible for the proper disposal/recycling of any waste generated by this project; 6) is not liable for any incidental or consequential damages caused by the installation of the equipment or for any damage caused by malfunction of the installed equipment; 7) does not guarantee that a specific level of energy or cost savings will result from the implementation of energy efficiency measures or the use of products funded under this program; **8) may modify or end any cash rebate program at any time without notice.
