- **CFU Rebate Processing and Application Deadline:** Submit applications no later than March 31, 2019. Please allow up to six weeks for rebate processing. Incomplete applications may be delayed or rejected. *CFU reserves the rights to award rebates in the form of utility bill credits or directly mailed checks, notify you of rebate status via text message, and to verify invoices and proof of payment with financial institutions. Receipts documenting cash transactions are not a valid proof of payment.*
